

Prayerwalking the Campus of *La Universidad Politécnica*

“And whatsoever you ask for in prayer, believing, you shall receive.” (Matthew 21:22)

1. E.U.I.T. Agrícola (School of Farming/Agriculture)



As we walk toward the agriculture school, ask God to give you wisdom throughout this prayerwalk. Pray that the Lord would open your mind to the needs of the students on this campus. Ask for believers to be placed within these buildings to share the good news. Pray that they will be bold.

2. E.T.S.I. Agrónomos (another part of the agriculture school)

Ask God to open students’ eyes and hearts and bring glory to Himself through their studies.

“Father, glorify Your name ... I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again.” (John 12:28)

Pray for the Lord to use the information being learned and studied to beckon the hearts of the professors and students alike. Ask for believers to be strategically placed among those who do not yet believe.



3. E.T.S.I. Aeronáuticos (School of Aeronautical Engineering)



As we walk toward the engineering school, ask God to draw to Himself each student who travels this path. Ask for conversations about spiritual things – most importantly, about Jesus – to take place among students.

“For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel, not in cleverness of speech, so that the cross of Christ would not be made void.” (1 Corinthians 1:17)

Pray for these students as they spend time focusing on their studies and learning. Ask that they will hear God's soft voice in the silence of the study hour. Petition that the Lord would bring quietness and solitude into their lives in order for them to ...

*"Be still and know that I am God."
(Psalm 46:10)*

Ask God to raise up leaders after His own heart who will gain the respect and friendship of the other students.



4. E.U.I.T. Aeronáutica (School of Aeronautics)



Pray that as God draws students to Himself, they would develop the same desire and zeal for His truth that they currently have for their studies. Ask that the Spirit would take away the things that veil their spiritual eyes, and that He would liberate them.

*"Whenever a person turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away ... where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty."
(2 Corinthians 3:16-17)*

5. The walk back to the Metro (Madrid's subway system)



*"Behold, I have put My words in your mouth."
(Jeremiah 1:9b)*

Pray for the SyncroNations-based English discussion groups on this campus, and ask God to grant favor to the groups' facilitators as they meet students. Ask for opportunities for the gospel to be shared during or outside the group meetings. Pray God would place His words in leaders' hearts and mouths.
